
From Pastor Nicole Herda, St. Peter's UCC Kiel:

You are invited to participate in the Rural Soup cookoff January 19th at Laack's Tavern and Ballroom.

This year 25 people from five of our local congregations (from 9th grade- retired adults with varying skillsets) will be heading to central Appalachia as they serve the Appalachia Service Project (ASP). It costs \$500 per person for a week which includes the cost of our travel, lodging (often in a school), meals, supplies, and college staffers. To afford the trip, we need help.

For \$10 per adult or \$5 per kid twelve and under, you can sample homemade soups. There are also raffle baskets and baked goods available! Participants vote on the best soup with their donations.
